LNIB Audit Committee:

This committee is to assist the Director of Finance and Chief and Council in the financial administration of LNIB. It is a standing committee.

LNIB Trespassing Committee:

This committee is to assist LNIB in better monitoring and enforce trespassing by-laws, especially relating to cattle and horses on Hamilton Indian Reserve.

LNIB Community Consultative Committee:

This Committee is made of members representing the different neighbourhoods of LNIB focusing on community safety and security, and law and order. The Committee will work closely with the Merritt Detachment of the FN Community Policing officers.

LNIB Prosperity Committee

This Committee is to assist in the development of LNIB Comprehensive Community Plan, and based on extensive community engagement. Leanne Joe, Strategic Initiatives Coordinator, will coordinate the work of this committee. The Term of this committee is June 30th, 2016.

LNIB Tshilhqot'in Committee:

This committee is to study and make recommendations to Chief and Council on developing strategies to take full advantage of Tshilhqot'in SCC decision. The term of this Committee is June 30th, 2016

LNIB School Board:

This committee will assist in the development and review of policies for LNIB School, and will work with the School Principal. It is a standing committee.

LNIB Education Policy Committee:

The mandate of this committee is to review and provide recommendations to Chief and Council on Education policies. We will likely retain the services of a consultant to do the leg work, present it to committee, who will review it, and present suggestions to Chief and Council. The term of this committee is February 26th, 2016.

LNIB Language Nest Committee:

This is a committee that will help us in developing the language nest. It is a standing committee.

LNIB Land Code Committee:

This committee will assist in the development and implementation of the land code.

LNIB Irrigation Management Committee:

This committee will look at the irrigation management and assess problems and find solutions for the irrigation system among within LNIB lands.

LNIB Cultural Committee:

This committee will bring ideas to help revitalize the Nlakapamux culture within the LNIB organization.
