

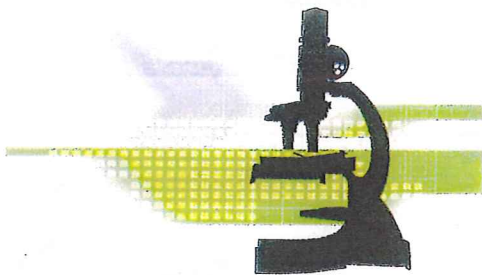
What is the Spectra Energy Scholarship?

4. Each student is required to submit a cover letter, outlining his/her academic goals, academic achievements and future goals.

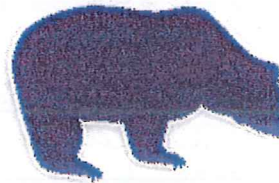
